- ✓ Perform effective ANTT on every occasion of aseptic practice
- ✓ Have undertaken education in ANTT in the last 24 months
- ✓ Have been competency assessed in ANTT theory & practice in the last 36 months

Every healthcare organization should:

-  **Have** a single standard policy & practice for aseptic practice
-  **Provide** ANTT education to clinical staff
-  **Ensure** clinical staff are competency assessed in ANTT
-  **Perform** periodic audit of aseptic practice
